The **World Association for Wines & Spirits Writers and Journalists (WAWWJ)** places this family company from Jerez in **first place** with regards to Spanish wineries in the ranking for Wineries of the Year,

This worldwide classification of Wineries of the Year is based on the prizes achieved by the wineries in international and domestic wine competitions, classified by importance and category. Of the 100 companies included in the list **only 5 are Spanish**, situating Spain in 6th place in the classification by country. In total 65 different countries are included in the list.

‘Winery of the Year’ is awarded to the winery which receives the most accumulated points throughout the year. This recognition has been awarded since 1997 by the association which brings together wines and spirits journalists, writers, social communicators and authors of web pages from all over the world.
