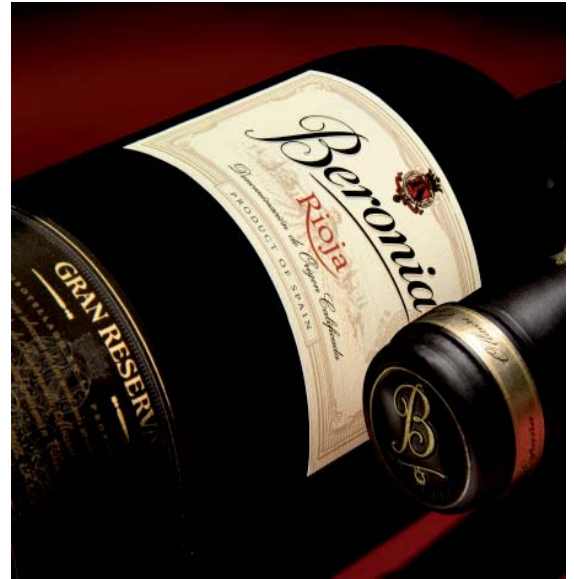

Tasting Note

1996 was a very good vintage for the La Rioja region with the resulting wines showing excellent ageing potential.

Medium to high intensity of colour. Cherry red with light brick tones. Fine and elegante, with cherry fruit aromas and hints of balsamic and tobacco. Smooth and velvety with good structure and perfectly balanced oak. Harmonic yet persistent finish.
