Quady ports are made from vineyards located in Amador and Madera Counties, the Amador vineyards furnishing the fruit for Quady's long-lived Vintage Starboard. Even in those years where no vintage is declared, the Amador County wines have higher tannins and color. But since only a small portion of Amador County fruit is used for vintage Starboard, the balance, nearly as good in quality, is aged an extra year or two in wood, to soften the wine, and bottled as LBV.

Quady's LBV wines are characterized by rich, complex flavors, excellent body, and soft supple tannins. An important feature of Quady's LBV is its marvelous value.
