Andeluna 2008 Torrontés 5 stars

Andeluna 2007 Chardonnay 4+ stars

Both wines are screw caps, and are great values. The Chardonnay is full bodied, smoothly textured, and quite fruity in style; with intense and complex aroma / flavors (pineapple, toast, baked bread, pear, grapefruit, honey), and a long finish. The Torrontés is aromatic, nearly dry, and full bodied; an exceptional wine, with supple texture, some richness, and a long, persistent finish, tasting of peach, jasmine, grapefruit, lychee nut, and guava.



Andeluna 2007 Merlot 5 stars

Andeluna 2007 Malbec 4+ stars

Andeluna 2007 Cabernet Sauvignon 4 stars

A trio of top value Argentine reds. The Cabernet is a supple, full bodied, well balanced wine, with moderate richness, slight oak character, and a medium long finish, tasting of plum, kola nut, spicy oak, and blackberry. The Malbec is truly excellent, in a supple, full, well balanced style. It has ripe fruit character (blackberry, plum) with overtones of black pepper, toast, spicy oak, and orange blossom. The Merlot is exceptional: ripe and supple, with rich fruitiness (cherry, blackberry) and overtones of roasted nut, spicy oak, and vanilla.
