

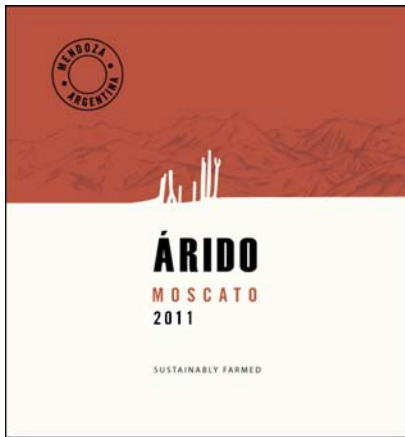

Varietal: Moscatel 100%

Vineyard Location:

Barrancas and Medrano
Mendoza - Argentina
Parral Vines



Soil:

Sandy loam with limestone.
Low to medium fertility with low percentage of organic material.
Very permeable and with low salt content.

Weather:

Cold winters and warm summers with mild temperatures during the day and cool nights.
During the vegetative season, there is a difference of temperature between day and night of approximately 60° F.

Harvest:

Hand harvested during the second week in March.

Tasting Notes:

Yellowish color with green notes. In the nose there is bright apple and pear fruit aromas combined with roses. In the palate the sweetness does not overpower the fruit and the fizzyness makes it very appealing. Balanced soft acidity.
