### **Appellation**

The flavor, intensity and complexity of Santa Rita Hills Pinot Noir come from a combination of unique east-west coastal valleys, passionate winegrowers and modern winegrowing techniques. Cool weather, fog, wind and our soils limit vine vigor, crop yield and intensify the flavors of our wines. Distinct geology and geography combine to form an absolutely unique maritime corridor. These two east-west oriented valleys (centered around Santa Rosa Road and Highway 246) represent some of the most incredible dirt and unique climatic influence in the Pinot Noir world.

### **Nose**

Black currant, cherry, plum and cranberry.

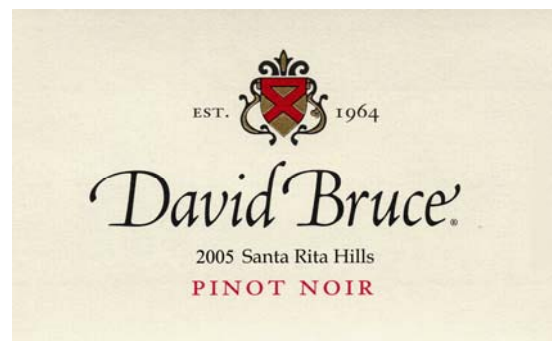
### **Palate**
