**Appellation**

An important and defining feature of this appellation is the distinctive combination of coastal coolness and afternoon heat which allows early-ripening varieties such as Pinot Noir to mature slowly and concentrate on the character of the fruit without losing its natural acidity. Our gentle handling process allows us to preserve the intensity of fruit flavors associated with Pinot Noirs from this region.

**Nose**

An elegant expression of rich cherry, white mulberry, hint of strawberry, raspberry and vanilla.

**Palate**

Red cherry, strawberry, pomegranate, plum, vanilla, walnut and clove. Fine tannin structure with a long finish.
